Name: 24-Hour Study Centre

Project Brief:

Most universities abroad, and some IITs, have 24-hour libraries. Having such a facility would encourage scholarship and study. But it is infeasible to keep our library open all the time. Perhaps a special study centre from the amount sponsored by Batch of 2014 could be built that would remain open all day and night, with quiet cubicles and a internet connection, so that students who would like to work through the night can do so undisturbed.

Benefits:

Mostly freshers are rooming in a double occupancy room and the space available is not enough for all of them to have tables and chairs. Since they don't have the facility to study at their room, they tend to do their academics in library.

Students who are rooming in a single occupancy room sometimes prefer to group study (be it girls/boys) in the library.

But library opens at 9 in the morning and closes at 12 midnight. If the said above wants to study apart from the mentioned time, they search for internet connection and a peaceful place to study.

So having a 24 hours Study Centre with cubicles, Wi-Fi internet connection and easily accessible for all categories of students will be really helpful to majority of the student community.
